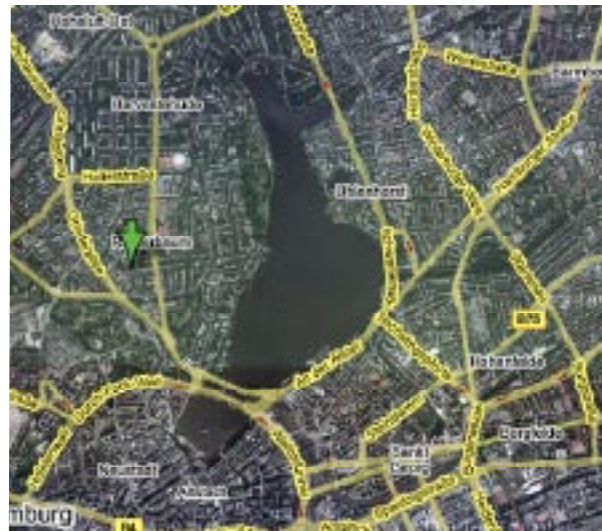
- communication theory and practice,
